DONATED ITEMS WE ACCEPT:

-) Clothing for men, women and children
-) Accessories (shoes, belts, hats, scarves etc.)
-) Furniture (dressers, coffee tables, night stands, book shelves, desks, chairs, etc.)
-) Household items (kitchenware, decorative items, art)
-) Books (Fiction, non-fiction, cookbooks etc. NO textbooks or encyclopaedias)
-) Linens (blankets, sheets, pillowcases, towels, tablecloths)
-) Jewelry including watches, brooches and charms
-) Records (includes 78s and 45s), VHS tapes, CD's and DVD's
-) Snowboards, Skates and Cross Country skis
-) Baby toys (no baby equipment)
-) Small microwaves and toaster ovens
-) Hockey sticks
-) Quality garage sale leftovers

DONATED ITEMS WE DO NOT ACCEPT:

-) Mattresses, box springs, day beds or bed frames
-) Futons or Hide-a-Beds
-) 3 seat sofas or recliners (no upholstered furniture or furniture in poor condition)
-) Large furniture (entertainment units, china cabinets etc.). *Some exceptions are made, please send email to vghthriftstore@shawbiz.ca with a photo attention to Store Manager for prior approval*
-) Computers, printers or fax machines
-) TV, stereo systems, VCR's or DVD players
-) Downhill Skis
-) Large appliances (refrigerators, stoves, washer/dryer etc.)
-) Baby equipment (bassinets, baby cribs, mattresses etc.)
-) Medical equipment or supplies
-) Pianos or organs
-) Kids' bike helmets (they have expiry dates)
-) Hockey helmets (they have expiry dates)
-) Smelly hockey pads
-) Stationary bikes, large exercise equipment or running machines
-) Vacuum cleaners of any kind

Please remember that all donations need to be clean and in good condition and electronics and appliances have to be in working order. We do not have the resources to clean or repair donated items. *As space is limited, ALL furniture must be approved by the Store Manager via email vghthriftstore@shawbiz.ca with a photo before donation.*
